c7istkten (winter home) Experience

60 MINUTES

Imagine what it would feel like to live in a "c7istkten" or pit-house, the traditional winter home of the Secwepemc people. Listen to stories of how our people lived before Europeans arrived up to the modern day.

Rattle Making Workshop

45 - 60 MINUTES

Rattles are used in ceremony, performance and personally by indigenous peoples. They are often used to pray for and honour the rains for the sound and connection between earth and sky. During the workshop the guests will be walked through stitching their rattle and filling it with stones to dry by one of our cultural interpreters. After which they will be shown how to complete their rattle once drying has finished.

Pictograph Painting

Paint your own pictograph, & listen to the Secwepemc history of pictographs. Your choice to paint on a river rock, or wooden carved feather. Lead by one of our cultural interpreters.

Your cultural interpretive guide will lead you around Secwepemc territory while sharing teachings about our Shuswap traditional landmarks and Secwepemc history. Policies

Guest Room Rate Policies & Notes:

- Rates are based on single or double occupancy.
- Additional charge of \$20.00 per person per night will apply to 3rd and 4th additional person(s).
- Children 12 years of age & under stay free when accompanied by an adult.
- Room rates are quoted in Canadian funds and are NET Non Commissionable.
- All room rates quoted exclude applicable taxes of 5%GST and 8%PST.
- Check-in time: 4:00 PM, Check out time: 11:00 AM

Payment & Cancellation Policies:

- Deposit required for all group bookings unless authorized billing has been established.
- Full Payment is required within 14 days of receipt of invoice unless other arrangements have been established.
- Cancelled Group Reservations (10+ rooms) are subject to the following penalties (cancellation of whole group):
 - If cancelled more than 45 days in advance of the scheduled arrival date, no penalty.
 - If cancelled 31 - 45 days in advance of the scheduled arrival date, a penalty equivalent to 10% of the room block value will be charged.
 - If cancelled 4 - 30 days in advance of the scheduled arrival date, a penalty equivalent to 50% of the room block value will be charged.
 - If cancelled within 3 or less days of the scheduled arrival date, a penalty equivalent to 100% of the room block value will be charged.
- Group Reservation partial cancellation (dropped rooms) will be subject to the following penalties:
 - An attrition rate of 20% of confirmed rooms in a group reservation will be permitted without penalty if cancelled within 4 – 30 days of the scheduled arrival date. For each room cancelled above the 20% threshold, a penalty of 50% of the room value will be charged.
 - For rooms cancelled from a group reservation within 3 days or less of the scheduled arrival date, a penalty equivalent to 100% of the room value will be charged.
- FIT cancellations may be made without penalty up to 72 hours prior to 4:00pm on the scheduled arrival date. No-Shows and cancellations made within 72 hours or less of 4:00pm on the scheduled arrival date will be subject to a cancellation fee equal to first night room + tax.

Food & Beverage Booking, Payment, and Cancellation Policies

- The number of persons guaranteed by the Client for function planning purposes is to be received in writing at least 7 days prior to the function date.
- If cancelled by the client less than 7 days prior to the function date, a minimum charge of equal to the food and beverage total, and all taxes, based on guaranteed attendance, will be charged.
- Any changes after 7 days prior to the function date will be billed according to the larger number of guests expected. Any additional guests are not guaranteed the same menu selection, however we will endeavor to do so.
- After menu confirmation, the Resort reserves the right to modify menu selection if the circumstance that the food or beverage items are unavailable. These items will be substituted with items of equal or greater value at no additional cost to the Client.
- All food and beverages are subject to 15% gratuity.
- All food and non-alcoholic beverages are subject to 5% GST.

- All alcoholic beverages are subject to 5%FNT and 10%PLT.
- Deposit required for all group bookings unless authorized billing has been established.
- Full Payment is required within 14 days of receipt of invoice unless other arrangements have been established.

Indigenous Cultural Program Booking, Payment, and Cancellation Policies:

- All rates unless otherwise indicated are net/non-commissionable and subject to applicable taxes.
- Please confirm these First Nations cultural programs at least 21 days in advance
- All cultural programming pricing excludes applicable 5% GST
- Cultural programming cancellations may be made without penalty up to 72 hours prior to 4:00pm on the scheduled program date. No-Shows and cancellations made within 72 hours or less of 4:00pm on the scheduled arrival date will be subject to a cancellation fee of 50% anticipated activity costs
- The Quaaout Lodge reserves the right to substitute or cancel an experience where conditions are deemed unsafe. In the event that the Quaaout Lodge cancels an event and an acceptable alternative activity is not available, a full refund will be issued.
- For experiences that involve a campfire, if our location is subject to a campfire ban due to extreme wildfire hazard, programs are adapted to provide an alternative experience that does not involve wood fire.

General Policies:

- All rates unless otherwise indicated are net/non-commissionable and subject to applicable taxes.
- **Rooming list must be received no later than 30 days prior to arrival date.**
- **Block Release Date: Guest room block and group rate are confirmed upon receipt of this contract until 30 days prior to arrival. Any rooms left in the room block, which remain unreserved on the release date will be released back to the hotel for general sale. After this date rooms and rate will be based on availability.**
- Porterage charge for groups of \$8.00 per bag (round trip) plus 5% GST.
- The Quaaout Lodge is a 100% non-smoking property. A charge of \$200.00 will be levied against any guest who smokes in any guest room, meeting room or public space within the confines of the hotel.
