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TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Rates are net, non-commissionable, quoted in Canadian dollars and based on single to double occupancy.
- Rates are subject to applicable taxes (PST) Provincial Sales Tax 8%; (GST) Goods & Services Tax 5% and Municipal Tax 3% (a total combined tax of 16%) and are subject to change without notice.
- All rates are subject to space and availability at time of booking.
- An additional charge of \$30 per person per night plus tax will apply to guestrooms with 3 guests or more.
- Due to Fire regulations we do not allow cots in our rooms. Extra persons must share existing beds.
- An upgrade to a Superior King room is available for an additional \$30 per night. Superior Rooms are located on the top floors, many with Mountain views.
- Check in time is 4pm and check out time is 11am.
- Minimum age of at least 1 guest checking in MUST be 25 years.
- Children 18 years of age or younger stay free when accompanied by an adult using existing bedding.
- We will do our best to accommodate bed configuration requests, however we can't guarantee until check-in.
- Connecting deluxe rooms are available for an additional \$10 per night to guarantee the connection. Bed configuration and availability will be confirmed upon reservation confirmation.

FIT PAYMENT & CANCELLATION POLICY

- Cancellations or reduction in room nights within 48 hours of arrival will forfeit the full amount.
- Full payment is required within 30 days of departure. Late payments will be assessed 2% interest per month.
- If paying by wire transfer, funds must be in Canadian dollars and an additional \$15 must be added to all payments to cover bank fees.

AD HOC GROUP RATES

PORTERAGE

Porterage is available to your clients. The handling fee is \$9 plus GST per piece, round trip.

PARKING

Underground parking is available to registered hotel guests at a rate of \$22 plus taxes, per night. Guests will be responsible for their own parking charges.

INCIDENTALS: The guest will be required to provide a credit card upon check-in to cover any incidental charges not covered by the tour operator and must be paid by the individual prior to departure. A pre-authorization of \$50 per night to a maximum of \$150 will be taken at check-in.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

The guaranteed check-in time is 4:00 PM; check-out time is 11:00 AM. Change room facilities and baggage storage can be provided for late departures or early arrivals. Early or late check-out cannot be confirmed.

CONDITIONS OF USE

1. The rates quoted in this contract are confidential and may not be published in print without the written permission of the Hotel.
2. Rates are net for the purpose of packaging and must not be sold online as a room only rate.



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3. The Tour Operator will under no circumstances offer hotel rates or availability to any online third party company. If a Tour Operator offers rates to online third parties, the Aava Whistler Hotel will have the right to cancel this contract.
4. All rooms are subject to availability at time of booking. The hotel may recall room allotment at their discretion.

IMPOSSIBILITY OF PERFORMANCE

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform or delay in performing any obligation under this agreement, including obligation to make payments when due. If such failure or delay is due to an act of God; war, embargo, riot, insurrection, sabotage or other civil unrest; fire, explosion, flood or other natural disasters; strike or other labour disturbances; government restraints; construction or necessary renovation; sale of Hotel or any other cause beyond the control of the affected party; provided, however, that the party so failing to perform shall (a) as soon as possible, inform the other party of the occurrence of the circumstances preventing or delaying the performance of its obligations; and (b) exert its best efforts to eliminate, cure or overcome any such causes and to resume performance of its covenants with all possible speed.

INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party and its employees, members, landlord, successors and assigns, from any claims, liabilities, losses, damages and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees) asserted against the other party and arising out of the indemnifying party's negligence, willful misconduct and negligent performance of, or negligent failure to perform, any of its duties or obligations under this Agreement. The provisions of this indemnification are solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and not intended to create or grant any rights, contractual or otherwise, to any other person or entity.
