This will help both your group and clubhouse to provide and experience better customer service.

Rental of power carts by you and your group are the sole responsibility of the individual players paying at our partner golf courses.

Parking fees if applicable are never included in our packages unless we specifically comment on this inclusion.

CHANGES TO YOUR ITINERARY: Due to the increased level of activity and unusually high demand, availability at golf courses and hotels is now very limited with facilities near full capacity. This means that changes to the tee times or hotel reservations within your golf trip package may not be possible as your travel dates approach. Along with our hotel and golf course partners, we will do our best to accommodate adjustments. Please review the Change Fee information contained in our Golf Package Terms & Conditions.

Please be aware that groups such as 6 (playing as 3 and 3) may have singles join them. We always make an effort to keep groups to themselves but sometimes it is simply unavoidable and courses will make all final decisions.

Hotel photos & text descriptions on our website(s) are sometimes for illustrative and general descriptive purposes, they may not reflect the exact room(s) you have booked. Generally rooms are standard with 1 queen or 2 double beds, room configurations and bedding details are noted in your itinerary / voucher PDF well as upgraded rooms and special requests.

Please assume all hotels are 100% non-smoking unless we specifically note in your itinerary otherwise, smoking in a room can lead to cleaning fees of \$200 to \$300 per room. Guests will be asked to provide credit card for room(s) incidentals and damage deposits.

2022 Group Guidelines at Highland Pacific

Number of Players: An estimated number of guests, for planning purposes, is required at the time of booking. For the 2022 season Highland Pacific Golf will take bookings of up to 24 players with the payment of an advanced booking fee of \$20 per player. As the group planner or tour operator, it is your responsibility to contact Highland Pacific Golf if the number of players change. A confirmed and final number of guests is required 7 days prior to your group outing.

Listing of Players: A final list of golfer pairings broken down into groups of four must be provided to Highland Pacific no later than 2 days before your group outing.

Attire and Equipment: All players are expected to wear appropriate golf attire. Dress code: shirts with collar or sleeves, blouses, slacks or tailored shorts. No tank tops, sweat pants, halter tops, undershirts, cut-off shorts or ripped jeans are allowed. Each player must have his or her own set of golf clubs. We have a limited supply of Callaway rental clubs. Highland Pacific Golf is a non-metal spike facility.

Damage: In the event of damage to the course or any of Highland Pacific Golf's property, you, as the Event Planner or tour operator, will be liable for any and all damages. Highland Pacific Golf reserves the right to inspect and monitor all events, and to discontinue service to some or all guests in the event of violation of Highland Pacific Golf Policies or Provincial law. The charges for all damage will include but not be limited to: parts and labor to restore the damaged property/and or replacement costs. Should Highland Pacific Golf discontinue service to all guests, the Event Planner shall remain liable for all amounts owed to Highland Pacific Golf.

Power Cart Rental Agreement: It is important for the Event Planner or Tour Operator to communicate to your point of contact how many golf carts you will need. In order to avoid confusion, please do not have your guests call the golf shop to book carts individually. Drivers are required to be 18 years or older.

Alcoholic Beverages: No outside alcohol is to be brought on to Highland Pacific Golf property. If anyone is seen with outside alcohol, it will be confiscated by our staff and given back later. If this behavior is continued they will

be asked to leave the course immediately. All alcoholic beverages, at the course, are to be supplied by Highland Pacific Golf.

Pace of Play: Highland Pacific Golf recognizes the importance of timeliness of play during an event. In appreciation of the skill levels of golfers playing in your outing, Highland Pacific Golf has established the following rule: Any group deemed excessively slow and that is affecting the speed of play of others behind them will be requested by the Player Assistants to advance a hole.
